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# Socio-economic development of the Republic of Kazakhstan in January-November 2023

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# 1. Social indicators

## **Population size and migration**


The population of the country as of November 1, 2023 amounted to 19992 thousand people, including urban – 12411 thousand (62%), rural – 7581 thousand (38%) people.

In January-October 2023, compared to January-October 2022, the number of arrivals in Kazakhstan increased by 65.1%, the number of departures from Kazakhstan decreased by 36.9%.

The main migration exchange of the country takes place with the CIS countries. The share of arrivals from the CIS countries and departures to these countries amounted to 87.6% and 77.9%, respectively.

The number of migrants moving within the country increased by 27.4%. In terms of interregional movements, a positive net migration of population has developed in 3 regions of the country: the cities of Astana (42412 people), Almaty (36029 people) and Shymkent (2092 people).

Changes in the rate of population growth





# Income of the population

The average per capita nominal cash income of the population, according to an estimate in October 2023, amounted to 177464 tenge (preliminary data), which is 4% higher than in October 2022, real cash income for the specified period decreased by 6.1%.



# **Employment of the population**

The number of employees at enterprises (organizations) in the III quarter of  $2023^{3}$  amounted to 3926.2 thousand people, of which at large and medium-sized enterprises -2872.6 thousand people.

In the III quarter of 2023, 305.0thousand people were hired by enterprises. 303.2 thousand people dropped out for various reasons. Worked by one employee 459.3 hours.

At the end of the III quarter of 2023, 55.9 thousand vacancies were not filled at enterprises (1.4% of the number of employees).



### The number of employees at enterprises and organizations for the III quarter of 2023

The number of unemployed, determined according to the methodology of the ILO, in the III quarter<sup>1)</sup> of 2023 amounted to 451.5 thousand people, the unemployment rate was 4.7%.

The employed population<sup>2)</sup> amounted to 9106 thousand people, including employees -6916.1 thousand people, individual entrepreneurs -1595.2 thousand people, persons engaged in private practice -21.7 thousand people, individuals, who are founders (participants) of business partnerships and founders, shareholders (participants) of joint-stock companies, as well as members of production cooperatives -12.3 thousand people, independent workers -560.7 thousand people.

In the III quarter of 2023, the average monthly nominal salary of one employee amounted to 350542 tenge (excluding employees of small enterprises engaged in entrepreneurial activities).

In the III quarter of 2023, the median salary was estimated to be 243924 tenge.

From January 1, 2023, the minimum wage is set at 70000 tenge.

# 2. Economic indicators

#### Statistics of prices

The consumer price index in November 2023 compared to October 2023 was 101%. Prices for paid services increased by 1.7%, food products – by 0.7%, non-food products – by 0.5%.

The main contribution to inflation was made by an increase in utility tariffs. Tariffs for central heating increased by 16.1%, hot water – by 8.1%, garbage collection – by 7.7%, cold water – by 5%, electricity – by 4.4%, sanitation – by 0.9%. Prices for air passenger transport services increased by 27%.

Of food products, prices for cucumbers increased by 42.1%, tomatoes – by 39%, eggs – by 5.6%, sweet pepper – by 3.5%, rice – by 1.4%, flour – by 1.2%, confectionery, bakery and flour products – by 0.6%. An increase in prices was noted for mineral and drinking water by 0.8%, tobacco products – by 0.7%, alcoholic beverages – by 0.4%. Carrots fell by 6.3%, potatoes, cabbage – by 5.7%, onions – by 4.4%.

An increase in prices in November this year was noted for cars, a laptop by 2.2%, an electric heater by 0.8%. Coal and firewood rose in price by 1%.

In November 2023, compared with the previous month, the producer price index for agricultural products amounted to 99.5%, crop production – 99.2%, livestock products – 100.2%.

Prices for rice paddyincreased by 2.5%, wheat – by 0.7%, oats– by 0.5%, and prices for corn (maize) - decreased by 4.4%, buckwheat – by 3.7%, sunflower seeds – by 3.6%, forage crops – by 2.3%, rape seeds – by 2.2%, barley – by 1.3%. Cucumbers of the closed ground rose in price by 13.2%, tomatoes of the closed ground– by 9.1%, and potatoes fell in price by 1.8%, table beets – by 0.6%.

Pigs rose in priceby 0.9%, horses – by 0.5%, and poultry meat fell in price by 1.4%. Prices for eggsincreasedby 2.9%, cow's milk – by 0.4%.

Prices of manufacturing enterprises for industrial products in November 2023 decreased by 1.5% compared to the previous month. Oil prices were lower by 4.9%, natural gas – higher by 1.3%, metal ores – by 0.4%. Of petroleum products, propane and butane liquefied rose by 2.7%. An decrease in prices was noted for lead by 7.2%, copper – by 2.6%, aluminum – by 2.5%, for rolled ferrous metals – a increase by 3%, precious metals – by 2.3%. From food products, wheat flour rose by 2.7%, livestock meat – by 1.5%, pasta – by 1.4%, bread – by 1.3%, cereals – fell by 3.5%, vegetable oil – by 2.9%.

In the service sector, tariffs for the carriage of goods by all modes of transport in November 2023 compared to Oktober 2023 increased by 0.3%, tariffs for communication services, postal and courier services have not changed.

In November 2023 compared to the previous month the price index in construction and for construction and installation work amounted to 100.4%, for machinery and equipment – 100.7%, for other work and costs – 100.2%.

# **Gross domestic product**

In the structure of GDP for January-September 2023, preliminary data, the production of goods amounted to 37.1%, the production of services - 54.2%. The main share in the production of GDP is occupied by industry - 27.7%, wholesale and retail trade; repair of cars and motorcycles - 15.8%.

### **Investment statistics**

In January-November 2023, the volume of investments in fixed capital amounted to 15292.5 billion tenge, which is 14.6% more than in January-November 2022.

The predominant sources of investment financing remain the own funds of economic entities, the volume of which in January-November 2023 amounted to 11487 billion tenge.

In January-November 2023, compared with January-November 2022, there is an increase costs for the purchase of machinery, equipment and vehicles and their capital repairs by 31.4%.

A significant share of investments in fixed capital in January-November 2023 accounted for mining and quarrying (27.6%), operations with real estate (18.2%), transport and warehousing (14%) and manufacturing industry (9.1%). The volume of investments of large enterprises in January-November 2023 amounted to 6103.5 billion tenge.

## Statistics of domestic trade


The volume of retail trade in January-November 2023 amounted to 16793.1 billion tenge, which is 7.7% more than the corresponding period in 2022. Retail sales of goods by trading enterprises increased by 11.7%, individual entrepreneurs, including those trading in the markets, increased by 0.1% compared to January-November 2022.

As of December 1, 2023, the volume of commodity stocks of trading enterprises (for reporting enterprises) in retail trade amounted to 1563.3 billion tenge, in trading days - 65 days.

The share of food products in the total volume of retail trade is 32.4%, non-food products – 67.6%. The volume of sales of food products compared to January-November 2022 decreased by 3.9%, non-food products increased by 14.3%.

The volume of wholesale trade in January-November 2023 amounted to 36817.7 billion tenge, or 12.8% more than the corresponding period in 2022. Non-food products and industrial and technical products (82.7%) prevail in the structure of wholesale trade.

## Statistics of foreign and mutual trade

#### According to SRCM Fand BNS

Foreign trade turnover in January-October 2023 amounted to 114,1 billion US dollars (increased by 2.6% in nominal terms compared to January-October 2022), including exports –64,6 billion US dollars (8,9% less) and imports – 49,5 billion US dollars (increased by 22,8%).

Exports with the EAEU countries amounted to 8986 million US dollars, or 13,2% more than in January-October 2022, imports -14317,8 million US dollars, decreased by 9,3% compared to the corresponding period last year.

Gross output of products (services) of agriculture, forestry and fisheries in January-November 2023 amounted to 8204.4 billion tenge, including gross crop production - 4309.9 billion tenge, Livestock - 3847.3 billion tenge, services in agriculture - 10.6 billion tenge, the volume of products (services) in the hunting sector - 1.4 billion tenge, in forestry - 17.7 billion tenge, in fisheries and aquaculture - 17.5 billion tenge.



## Statistics of industrial production

The volume of industrial production in January-November 2023 amounted to 42130,7 billion tenge. In the mining and quarrying industry – 19880,2 billion tenge, in the manufacturing industry 19579,6 billion tenge, in the supply of electricity, gas, steam, hot water and air conditioning – 2309,4 billion tenge, in water supply, collection, waste treatment and disposal, pollution elimination activities – 361,5 billion tenge.

## Statistics of building and housing construction

In January-November 2023, the volume of construction work (services) amounted to 5918.9 billion tenge.

The largest amount of work in January-November 2023 was performed on the construction of facilities (2782.5 billion tenge), nonresidential buildings (2179.4 billion tenge) and residential buildings (957 billion tenge).

The volume of construction and installation work in January-November 2023 compared to January-November 2022 increased by 9% and amounted to 4981.9 billion tenge. The volume of construction work on capital repairs increased by 49.2% compared to the corresponding period last year, while on current repairs it increased by 23.6%.


In January-November 2023, the construction of 34428 new buildings was completed, of which 32357 are residential and 2071 are non-residential.

The following social and cultural facilities were put into operation:

- secondary school 70;
- preschool organizations 44;
- hospital 2;
- outpatient organizations 31.

as a percentage of the corresponding month of the previous year





In January-November 2023, 2672.2 billion tenge was allocated for housing construction. In the total volume of investments in fixed capital, the share of disbursed funds in housing construction amounted to 17.5%.

The main source of financing for housing construction in January-November 2023 is the own funds of developers, the share of which is 88.4%.

as a percentage of the corresponding month of the previous year




In January-November 2023, the total area of housing put into operation increased by 15.6% and amounted to 15067.2 thousand square meters, of which in multi-apartment buildings - by 28.5% (9107.9 thousand square meters). At the same time, the total area of individual residential buildings put into operation decreased by 0.5% (5862 thousand square meters)

In the total volume of commissioned housing, the share of multi-apartment buildings was 60.4%, individual - 38.9%. The average actual cost of construction of 1 square meter of total housing area increased by 18.6%.



# **Statistics of transport**

#### Cargo turnover

Cargo turnover for January-November 2023 decreased by 3.1% from the level of the corresponding period of the previous year. In January-November 2023, compared to January-November 2022, there is a increase in the turnover of railway transport (by 4.9%).





#### **Passenger turnover**

Passenger turnover in January-November 2023 increased by 11.2% compared to the corresponding period of the previous year. In January-November 2023, compared to January-November 2022, there is an increase in passenger traffic in road transport (by 4.3%) and air transport (by 32.1%).



## **Statistics of communications**

IPV for communication services in January- November 2023 compared to January- November 2022 amounted to 107.6%, of which 116.8% for Internet services, 105.1% for other telecommunications services and 95.7% for mobile services. A significant share in the total volume of communication services is occupied by Internet services, mobile communications and other telecommunication services, the shares of which amounted to 46.3%, 21.2% and 20.2 respectively.

# Small and medium business<sup>1)</sup>

#### The structure of performance indicators for SMEs as of December 1, 2023

According to the Statistical Business Register, the largest number of operating individual entrepreneurs is concentrated in Almaty city (16.7%) of the total, Astana city (11.2%), Turkistan (8.4%), Shymkent city (7.3%), Almaty (6.7%) and Karagandy (5.1%) regions.

At the same time, a significant number of active peasant or farm enterprises were recorded in Turkistan (30%), Zhambyl (11.1%), Almaty (10.6%) and Zhetisu (7.6%) regions.
