## Explanation of filling out the census form for the national census of the Republic of Kazakhstan in 2021 "Individual"

(index 3-I, Frequency: one-time)

1. The population census during the national census of the Republic of Kazakhstan in 2021 is carried out as of 00:00 hours by the time of the city of Nur-Sultan from August 31 to September 1, 2021.

The deceased after the moment of registration of the population are counted in the census form for the national census of the Republic of Kazakhstan in 2021 "Individual" (index 3-I, Frequency: one-time) (hereinafter - census sheet). Those born after the moment of registration of the population are not counted in the census form.

- 2. When filling out the questionnaire, appropriate marks are made in the listed answer options, if necessary, numbers and (or) text are entered.
- 3. The Census sheet is filled in separately for each respondent belonging to a household (hereinafter referred to as the respondent) living in the territory of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

For those temporarily absent within the enumerated household, minors, incapacitated respondents, other adult respondents, guardians or trustees of these respondents fill out the questionnaires.

If at the time of population registration the incapacitated respondent is at home, the guardian fills out a census sheet for him.

- 4. In questions 1, 2, 3, 4 of the census form, the personal data of the respondent are filled in.
- 5. In question 5 of the census form, item 1 refers to the respondent recorded first within the household in the census form for the national census of the Republic of Kazakhstan

in 2021, "List of residents and (or) staying" (Index 1-PP, Frequency: one-time).

A respondent living in the same household with both parents or one of them is filled out with a serial number, under which the mother or father is indicated in column 3 of paragraph 8 of the census form for the national census of the Republic of Kazakhstan in 2021 "List of residents and (or) staying "(Index 1-PP, Frequency: one-time).

If the respondent does not live in the same household with both parents or one of them, the mother's (father's) number is not filled in.

6. In question 16 of the questionnaire on item 1 "Primary education" and item 2 "Basic secondary education" are given in the Table for determining the level of education of respondents who have not received secondary (complete) general education, in combination with the number of classes in accordance with Appendix 1

to this explanation of how to fill out the questionnaire.

For respondents who graduated from educational institutions that do not provide general secondary education (for example, a vocational, industrial vocational school (IVS), a factory training school (FTS), a factory apprenticeship school (FAS), a training center,

training and production center, retraining and advanced training courses, preparatory courses at educational institutions, technical school (TS), vocational school (VS), city vocational school (CVS) and rural

vocational school (VS), vocational lyceum (VL), school, the education they received before entering these educational institutions is noted.

According to item 3 of the census form "General secondary education" is noted for respondents who graduated from 10-11 (12) grades in general education schools, lyceums, gymnasiums and specialized schools for gifted children who received a certificate of secondary general education.

According to item 4 of the census form "Primary vocational education" it is noted for the respondents:

- 1) who have received a working profession upon completion of training in organizations of primary vocational education (for example, a vocational school, a vocational lyceum a center of continuing education, a technical school (mining and mechanical, nautical, forestry));
  - 2) graduated from a vocational school (VS) or technical school;
- 3) graduated from a vocational and technical educational institution and received, along with the profession, a certificate of secondary education or received a profession on the basis of secondary education.

According to item 5 of the census form "Secondary vocational (special) education" is noted for respondents who graduated from technical schools.

According to item 6 of the census form "Technical and vocational education" is noted for respondents who graduated from schools, colleges and higher colleges on the basis of basic secondary and (or) general secondary education.

According to item 7 of the questionnaire, "Incomplete higher education" is noted for respondents who are students in higher educational institutions (HEI), and who have completed half or more than half of the period of study. The respondents who studied at a higher educational institution for less than half of the period of study are noted the level of education that they had before entering ("Technical and vocational education", "Secondary vocational education" or "General secondary education").

According to item 8 of the census form "Higher education" is noted for respondents who have completed their studies at higher educational institutions.

According to item 9 of the census form, "Postgraduate education" is noted for respondents who, at the time of the population registration, completed their studies in higher educational institutions under the program: master's, postgraduate, residency, doctoral studies.

7. Questions 22, 23, 24 of the questionnaire are filled in for respondents 15

years old and older. Respondents under the age of 15 who are actually married should choose the appropriate answer.

- 8. Questions 25, 26, 27 of the census form are filled in by women of the indicated age group, regardless of their marital status.
  - 9. In question 29 of the questionnaire:

under paragraph 1, an employee refers to a respondent working under an employment contract that provides for payment (remuneration) in the form of a salary, bonus, allowances, and the like, or in kind, as well as elected, appointed or approved for a paid position, serving in The Armed Forces, other troops and military formations, law enforcement and special government agencies;

under paragraph 2, an employer is a respondent who runs his own enterprise or is engaged in professional, commercial activities on an independent basis and employs one or more employees;

according to paragraph 3, an individual employed is a respondent who works on an individual basis (both registered with the tax authorities and not registered with the tax authorities) and does not hire employees;

according to paragraph 4, a respondent employed only in his personal subsidiary farm (agricultural work and (or) caring for livestock) and using the produced products for partial consumption, exchange (sale) refers to a person engaged in a personal subsidiary farm (personal backyard) partial own consumption, exchange (sale);

according to paragraph 5, a respondent employed in his personal subsidiary farm (agricultural work and (or) caring for livestock) and using products produced in the subsidiary farm for his own consumption is referred to as employed in a personal subsidiary farm (personal backyard) for his own consumption;

according to clause 6, a member of a production cooperative is a respondent who works at his own enterprise (cooperative) that produces goods and services, where each member of the collective of owners has equal rights in dealing with issues of organizing production, marketing products, investing and distributing income between members of the enterprise (cooperative);

according to clause 7, a respondent who works (helps) without payment in a private enterprise (individual, family), in a peasant (farm) farm, a production cooperative owned by relatives refers to a helping (unpaid) employee of family organizations, peasant or farms;

paragraph 8 refers to persons who are imprisoned by a court decision, as well as persons doing unpaid military or alternative civilian service.

- 10. Question 30 of the questionnaire indicates the branch of the main work. An explanation of the types of economic activity is given in Appendix 2 to this explanation for filling out the census form.
- 11. Questions 36, 37, 38, 39 of the questionnaire indicate the difficulties that the respondent faces in everyday life when performing certain actions due to health problems (vision, hearing, motor system, memory and / or concentration). Temporary health problems such as colds, injuries, fractures and more are not included.

12. Question 40 of the questionnaire is asked to respondents who answered "Yes, I am experiencing great difficulties" in column 3 and "Yes, completely limited in actions" in column 4 of questions 36, 37, 38, 39 of the questionnaire.
